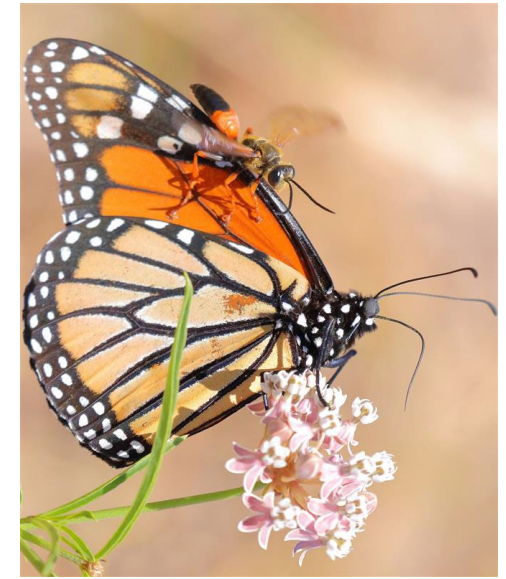






# Monarch Habitat Restoration

- Work will be done by school kids (if allowed), volunteers, and Conservation Corps members
- Plant up to 1,500 nectar and host plants for the monarch butterfly
- Target nectar plants that flower different times of the year
- Provides nectar for other pollinators as well
- Adjacent to the Fisher Creek Riparian Habitat Restoration Project (BEF)
