



# Traditional Redistricting Principles

There are a number of criteria that have been used nationally and upheld by courts.

- Relatively equal size people, not citizens
- Contiguous districts should not hop/jump
- Maintain "communities of interest"
- Follow city/county/local government lines
- Keep districts compact appearance/function

   Neighborhood & Other small changes






# Draft Map A




# Draft Map B




Working from Map C, this new version makes the following changes:




