Traditional Redistricting Principles


There are a number of criteria that have been used nationally and upheld by courts.

- Relatively equal size - people, not citizens
- Contiguous – districts should not hop/jump
- Maintain “*communities of interest*”
- Follow city/county/local government lines
- Keep districts compact – appearance/function

This plan makes minimal changes to the current lines, while seeking to unify cities and neighborhoods.





Total Deviation: 3.9%







- Uses San Carlos as the border between Districts 3 and 4


