**SUBJECT**

Approve Award of Contract to Full Boar Trapping and Wildlife Control LLC for RFP 2025-06 Feral Pig Management

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Board authorize the General Manager to enter a contract with Full Boar Trapping and Wildlife Control LLC ("Full Boar LLC") to conduct Feral Pig Management in lands managed by the Authority in an amount not to exceed \$243,932.21 from May 22, 2025, through November 30, 2027.

**REVENUE/COST**

Funds for this three-year effort are carried in the Authority's general operating budget for Fiscal Year 2024/2025 and proposed for inclusion in Fiscal Year 2025/2026. Funds for this effort would also be proposed in Fiscal Year 26-27.

**BACKGROUND**

The Authority recognizes the damaging effects that invasive feral pigs can have on habitat, sensitive plant communities, water quality and water resources, and agricultural operations within the lands the Authority manages. The Authority recognizes that pig populations are increasing as well as the damage resulting from pigs, and that there is a need to take action. The Authority solicited proposals for feral pig management services at 3 trap locations for a period of 2.5 years (from May 22, 2025 until November 1, 2027, in areas with high pig activity and damage from pigs.

**DISCUSSION**

Staff prepared and posted a Request for Proposals (RFP) on its website and at the Administration Office window on April 25, 2025. The RFP was published in the San Jose Post Record on April 25, 2025 and May 2, 2025. The RFP was also emailed to at least 3 vendors who perform such services. A total of 3 proposals were received.

The proposals were reviewed and evaluated against the criteria set forth in the RFP by Authority staff members. These criteria included experience and qualifications of the Bidder, experience and qualifications of personnel and subconsultants employed by the Bidder, experience of the Bidder including past performance on contracts of similar size and scope, demonstrated understanding of the scope of the service, best overall financial return to the Board of Directors on the contract, and a responsible Bidder who has demonstrated the attribute of trustworthiness, as well as quality, fitness, and experience to satisfactorily perform the work required. Full Boar LLC's proposal meets the requirements identified in the RFP and indicates that Full Boar LLC would be capable of providing high quality feral pig management services for the Authority in the most fiscally responsible manner. The project is anticipated to commence on May 23, 2025, and continue through November 1, 2027.

## **RESOLUTION 25-30**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE SANTA CLARA VALLEY OPEN SPACE AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER OR ASSISTANT GENERAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH FULL BOAR TRAPPING AND WILDLIFE CONTROL LLC FOR RFP 2025-06 FERAL PIG MANAGEMENT**

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**WHEREAS**, the Santa Clara Valley Open Space Authority (Authority) proposes to contract a qualified specialist in feral pig management for a period of 2.5 years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority recognizes the damaging effects that invasive feral pigs can have on habitat, sensitive plant communities, water quality and water resources, and agricultural operations within the lands the Authority manages, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Authority recognizes that pig populations are increasing as well as the damage resulting from pigs, and that there is a need to take action; and

**WHEREAS**, staff prepared and posted a Request for Proposals (RFP) on its website and at the Administration Office window on April 25 and posted in the San José Post Record on April 25 and May 2 of 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, 3 proposals were submitted on May 9, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, staff reviewed the received proposals and found Full Boar Trapping and Wildlife Control LLC's proposal to meet the requirements identified in the RFP and that Full Boar Trapping and Wildlife Control LLC would be capable of providing high quality feral pig management services for the Authority in the most fiscally responsible manner, and

**WHEREAS**, after evaluating the responsive proposals submitted in response to the RFP, Full Boar Trapping and Wildlife Control LLC meets the criteria for the most responsible and qualified bidder which include:

- A. Experience of the Vendor including past performance of firm on contracts of similar size and scope.
- B. Experience and qualifications of personnel employed by the Vendor.
- C. Demonstrated understanding of the scope of the service.
- D. Best overall financial return to the Board of Directors on the contract.
- E. A responsible Vendor who has demonstrated the attribute of trustworthiness, as well as quality, fitness, and experience to satisfactorily perform the work required.

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends to the Board to award the contract to Full Boar Trapping and Wildlife Control LLC;

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**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Directors hereby awards Full Boar Trapping and Wildlife Control LLC the contract to provide feral pig management services, not to exceed \$243,932.21 from May 23, 2025 until November 30, 2027.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the General Manager is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the Authority and in its name, to execute and deliver such other documents and to do such acts as may be deemed necessary or appropriate to accomplish the intentions of the above resolution.
